



THEATER 101

How much do you know about theater? Each newsletter issue will provide information about the technical and behind the scenes aspects of the theater arts.

In many of our productions, we rent a "drop" which is a large painted piece of material that hangs from poles at the very back of the stage. The drop can set any scene from a field in the countryside to the inside of a castle to a jungle. Sometimes, like in our Winter 2013 production of ***Puss in Boots***, additional pieces are hung across the top or along the sides, just in front of the drop, in order to provide perspective. It saves time from building and painting a huge set and they provide elaborate, colorful designs. It is practically a talent in order to fold the drop back up and get it into the small box it came in though!
